Next, click on the magnifying glass on your Competence Requirements table of the course you wish to sit. Please note that the below is what each colour represents within the table represented on your left here. You will only need to subscribe or enrol in a course that is fully **RED**, if this is green at all that will mean you are already subscribed and enrolled.

Compliant with three months or more left

Not Compliant (may be expired or at a lower level or has never had the competence, check expiry date and level attained to see which)
